

## **Assistant, Associate, or Full Project Scientist - Perinatal Biologist**

The Department of Pathology (<http://pathology.ucsd.edu>) at the University of California San Diego School of Medicine UCSD is committed to academic excellence and diversity within the faculty, staff, and student body and seeks an Assistant, Associate, or Full Project Scientist.

UCSD recently launched the Center for Perinatal Discovery, which is primarily a collaboration between the Departments of Pathology, Obstetrics, Gynecology, and Reproductive Sciences, and Pediatrics. The overarching mission of the Center is to understand the effects of maternal health on pregnancy, and the effects of pregnancy exposures and outcomes on maternal and offspring health throughout the lifespan.

The successful candidates will be a part of the Center for Perinatal Discovery and will have the opportunity to be involved in multiple collaborations across laboratories within the Center. The successful candidates will be expected to be involved in small and large collaborative projects, teaching and supervising students and postdoctoral fellows. The successful candidate will also be expected to make original and significant contributions to a research program in a discipline relevant to stem cell, reproductive, and/or perinatal biology, and participate in all aspects of laboratory research, including experimental design, data analysis, and manuscript and grant writing.

Candidates must hold an MD, MD/PhD, or PhD in any biological sciences, stem cell, or reproductive biology-related fields.

Candidates with knowledge, work /training experience, and publications utilizing human iPSC-based disease models and/or mass cytometry/spatial genomics/proteomics are preferred.
