### **Abstract Submission**

Eligibility: All Rady Children's, UCSD employees and affiliates who conduct pediatric clinical research are eligible to submit an abstract. Abstracts describing original, pediatric clinical research may be submitted. By submitting your abstract, you agree to present the abstract if it is selected for a poster presentation.

### **Abstract Submission Format**

Abstracts should be typed in Arial 11 font and must be limited to 400 words or less. The abstract should be submitted via email to <a href="mailto:pedsresearch@ucsd.edu">pedsresearch@ucsd.edu</a> and should include the following:

### **Abstract Submission Deadline**

Abstracts must be received by 11:59 pm on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>September 23</u>, <u>2015</u>. Acknowledgment that materials arrived on time will be sent via email from <u>pedsresearch@ucsd.edu</u>.

### Selection and Notification

An abstract selection committee will meet during the first week of October. Notification of abstract acceptance will be sent via email, on or around, October 9, 2015. If the study has more than one author, the contact person is asked to share the information with the other author(s).

# Call for Ed Quigley Clinical Research Award Nominations

Rady Children's is seeking nominations for the Ed Quigley Clinical Research Award. An award recipient will be honored at the symposium. A \$1,000 prize will be presented to an individual Rady Children's staff member for their outstanding contribution to clinical research. Registered nurses and other hospital staff members (non-MD, non-PhD) who have facilitated, advocated for, and aided clinical research at Rady Children's qualify for this award. Nominations should include a synopsis of the individual's clinical research contributions, a description of the influence of those contributions on clinical research, and at least one additional supporting letter.

Please include in the nomination letter the nominee's title and contact information (work e-mail and phone number). Nominations should be submitted electronically by PDF attachment to <a href="mailto:pedsresearch@ucsd.edu">pedsresearch@ucsd.edu</a>.
