- **Summary Page (1 page)**
 - Complete contact information of PI including: full name and current academic title with the university, depart, phone number, email address
 - Title of this funding opportunity
 - Descriptive title of proposed research
 - Names of other key personnel (if applicable)
 - Participating institutions (if applicable)
- **Proposal (maximum of 4 pages including references)**

Tailored to address the sponsor's goals/focus (full details online) and including:

 - Goals and a statement of the importance of the research
 - Specific aims
 - Method of procedure

- **COMBINE ALL DOCUMENTS LISTED ABOVE INTO ONE PDF** and email to Limited Submission Committee at hsfunding@ucsd.edu by the date and TIME listed above.
- **In the body of your submission email, include your full name and contact information (often accomplished by including an email signature).**

- **One letter of recommendation is required (maximum of 2 pages)**
 - Please ask referee to confidentially submit their letter to hsfunding@ucsd.edu in advance of the internal deadline with the **title of this funding opportunity and your name included.**

UCSD will prescreen and select 1 applicant, as allowed by the sponsor, to move forward to the full application stage.

If selected, PI should be prepared to complete a full application pursuant to the sponsor's guidelines which may include the following items:

- **Budget**
- **Expanded application and proposal**
- **Additional reference letters**

All applications for funding must also be reviewed by the Office of Contracts and Grant Administration (OCGA). Upon receiving notification of passing internal review, the selected PI(s) will also be given the contact information for the appropriate OCGA officer. Coordination of the OCGA review will be direct between the PI and their OCGA contact.

Award Description: This Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) will continue the Coordinating Center (CC) for a research consortium, the Intestinal Stem Cell Consortium (ISCC). The consortium Coordinating Center will facilitate activities of the consortium and facilitate communication of research results, data and methods within the consortium and to the community. Eligible Individuals: Any individual(s) with the skills, knowledge, and resources necessary to carry out the proposed research as the Program Director(s)/Principal Investigator(s) (PD(s)/PI(s)) is invited to work with his/her organization to develop an application for support.
